## BACKGROUND

### Young Coach Education

From November 2023 to March 2024, a total of 39 Young Coaches from Ecuador successfully completed the Young Coach Education.

### Monitoring & Evaluation

As part of our monitoring and evaluation efforts, activities of Young Coaches are being tracked for a three-year period following the project to gain insights into its long-term impact.

The first survey took place in February 2025. In total, 31 (80%) of the 39 Young Coaches responded to the survey (Locations of Young Coaches illustrated to the left). Unfortunately, 8 Young Coaches could not be reached during this first survey.

## UPDATE RESULTS

- ❖ Based on the 2025 survey, at least 24 Young Coaches are still active. 7 Young Coaches are no longer coaching, with one stating they had to move due to the difficult security situation in the country.
- ❖ Survey data suggests that Young Coaches have now trained 69 Peer Young Coaches (up by 15% since 2024). This means that, on average, each Young Coach trained has passed on knowledge to almost 2 Peer Young Coaches.
- ❖ 71% of the active Young Coaches include educational messages in their activities, teaching their children about topics such as nutrition and hygiene, values, socio-emotional skills and social issues as well as safer internet use.

## Young Coaches' current activities...

of the certified Young Coaches have trained **Peer Young Coaches** to support them or to deliver their own activities.

**71%**



of the active Young Coaches deliver activities that include **educational messages**, e.g. healthy habits.\*

**83%**



of the active Young Coaches work with **boys as well as girls**.\*

**71%**



of the active Young Coaches include **children with disabilities** or are planning to do so in the future.\*

**67%**



of the active Young Coaches include **refugee children / asylum seekers**.\*
