BACKGROUND

Young Coach Education

Between April and July 2023, a total of 35 Young Coaches from Ukraine, Romania, Poland and Moldova successfully completed the Young Coach Education.

Monitoring & Evaluation

As part of our monitoring and evaluation efforts, activities of Young Coaches are tracked for a three-year period following the project to gain insights into its long-term impact.

The second survey took place in October 2025. For the 2nd survey 14 (40%) of the 35 Young Coaches responded (Locations of Young Coaches illustrated to the left). Unfortunately, 21 Young Coaches could not be reached during this second survey call.

UPDATE RESULTS

- ❖ Based on the 2025 survey, at least 12 Young Coaches are still active. 2 Young Coaches are no longer coaching, with one mentioning their higher education (college) as a reason why they stopped.
- ❖ Survey data suggests that Young Coaches have now trained 80 Peer Young Coaches (up by 8% since 2024). This means that, on average, each Young Coach trained in 2023 has passed on knowledge to at least 2 Peer Young Coaches.
- ❖ 67% of the active Young Coaches include educational messages in their activities, teaching their children about topics such as health and environmental protection, psychology and social skills.
